11 applicant's eligibility to vote, pursuant to s. 97.041, which
12 includes the information required for the uniform statewide
13 voter registration application pursuant to s. 97.052(2).

14 (c) Swear to the oath required pursuant to s. 97.051.

15 (3) (a) The online voter registration system shall comply
16 with the information technology security provisions of s.
17 282.318 and shall use a unique identifier for each applicant to
18 prevent unauthorized persons from altering a voter's
19 registration information.

20 (b) The division shall conduct a comprehensive risk
21 assessment of the online voter registration system before making
22 the system publicly available and every 2 years thereafter. The
23 comprehensive risk assessment must comply with the risk
24 assessment methodology developed by the Agency for State
25 Technology for identifying security risks, determining the
26 magnitude of such risks, and identifying areas that require
27 safeguards.
