**Explanation:**

Reduces funding from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Financial and Services Accountability System by \$500,000 in nonrecurring funds from the General Revenue Fund and provides \$500,000 in nonrecurring funds from the General Revenue Fund and \$500,000 in nonrecurring matching funds from the Medical Care Trust Fund to the Medical Schools Quality Network.

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In Section 03, on Page 63, DELETE the following:

From the funds provided in Specific Appropriation 302A, the nonrecurring sum of \$7,000,000 from the General Revenue Fund is provided to the Department of Children and Families for the development and implementation of a uniform management information and fiscal accounting

system for use by providers of community substance abuse and mental health services. The system must comply with section 394.77, Florida Statutes, and include automated interfaces to the department's child welfare information system and the Agency for Health Care Administration's Medicaid Management Information System.

and insert in lieu thereof:

From the funds provided in Specific Appropriation 302A, the nonrecurring sum of \$6,500,000 from the General Revenue Fund is provided to the Department of Children and Families for the development and implementation of a uniform management information and fiscal accounting system for use by providers of community substance abuse and mental health services. The system must comply with section 394.77, Florida Statutes, and include automated interfaces to the department's child welfare information system and the Agency for Health Care Administration's Medicaid Management Information System.

In Section 03, on Page 44, DELETE the following:

From the funds in Specific Appropriation 182, \$3,000,000 from the Grants and Donations Trust Fund and \$3,000,000 from the Medical Care Trust Fund may be used by the Agency for Health Care Administration to contract with the Florida Medical Schools Quality Network created under section 409.975(2), Florida Statutes.

and insert in lieu thereof:

From the funds in Specific Appropriation 182, \$500,000 in nonrecurring funds from the General Revenue Fund, \$3,000,000 from the Grants and Donations Trust Fund and \$3,500,000 from the Medical Care Trust Fund, of which \$500,000 is nonrecurring, may be used by the Agency for Health Care Administration to contract with the Florida Medical Schools Quality Network created under section 409.975(2), Florida Statutes, for projects relating to pediatric oral health awareness, improving birth outcomes, and reducing cesarean rates in the state.

Line item amendments are accepted as part of the amendatory process. However, due to the necessity of using computerized systems this may entail a different placement within a budget entity or the renumbering of the specific appropriation items.
