**Explanation:**

Provides \$2 million from the General Revenue Fund for the National Cancer Institute Centers Program and designates the Mayo Clinic Cancer Center as a Tier 1 National Cancer Institute. Eliminates funding provided to the Mayo Clinic Cancer Center to fund an endowed cancer research chair by \$2 million from the General Revenue Fund.

Immediately following Specific Appropriation 453, DELETE:

The funds in Specific Appropriation 453 are provided for the Florida National Cancer Institute (NCI) Centers Program established in s. 381.915, Florida Statutes.

Cancer centers are eligible for Tier 1, Tier 2 and Tier 3 designation to participate in the Florida NCI Centers Program as follows. H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and Research Institute is eligible for Tier 1 designation as an NCI-designated comprehensive cancer center. The University of Miami Sylvester Comprehensive Cancer Center and the University of Florida Health Shands Cancer Hospital are eligible for Tier 3 designation in the Florida NCI Centers Program. Tier 3 centers must provide a proposed timeline by September 15, 2015, to the Department of Health detailing plans to submit letters of intent, pre-application consultation, and an official application for the P30 Cancer Center Support Grant to the NCI at the National Institute of Health in order to receive funds through this program.
