Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Delete lines 17 - 29

and insert:

(1) As used in this section, the term:

(a) "First responder" includes a law enforcement officer as defined in s. 943.10(1), a firefighter as defined in s. 784.07, and an emergency medical care provider as defined in s. 784.07.

(b) "Harass" means to engage in a course of conduct directed at a first responder which causes substantial emotional

11 distress in that first responder and serves no legitimate
12 purpose.

13 (2) (a) It is unlawful for a person, after receiving a
14 warning not to approach from a first responder who is engaged
15 in the lawful performance of a legal duty, to violate such
16 warning and approach or remain within 20 feet of the first
17 responder with the intent to:

18 1. Interrupt, disrupt, hinder, impede, or interfere with
19 the first responder's ability to perform such duty;

20 2. Threaten the first responder with physical harm;
