10 (4) PHYSICIAN CERTIFICATION.—

11 (i) The department shall monitor physician registration in
12 the medical marijuana use registry and the issuance of physician
13 certifications for practices that could facilitate unlawful
14 diversion or misuse of marijuana or a marijuana delivery device
15 and shall take disciplinary action as appropriate. The
16 department may suspend registration of any qualified physician

17 from the registry for a period of up to two years if the
18 qualified physician does not comply with the provisions of this
19 section. The department may suspend the registration of any
20 qualified physician from the registry for a period of up to two
21 years if the qualified physician provides, advertises or markets
22 telehealth services prior to July 1, 2023.
