5 Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert:

6 Section 1. This act may be cited as the "Cassie Carli
 7 Law."

8 Section 2. Subsection (10) is added to section 61.13,
 9 Florida Statutes, to read:

10 61.13 Support of children; parenting and time-sharing;
 11 powers of court.—

12 (10) In a proceeding under this chapter where a court
 13 approves, grants, or modifies a parenting plan, the court must
 14 consider whether it is in the best interests of the minor child
 15 and the parties to require the parties to use a safe exchange

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16 location as provided in subsection (8), s. 125.01, F.S., for the
17 periodic exchange of the minor child.

18 Section 3. Subsection (8) is added to section 125.01,
19 Florida Statutes, to read:

20 125.01 Powers and duties.—

21 (8) (a) The board of county commissioners in each county
22 shall designate at least one parking lot at a sheriff's office,
23 or substation thereof, as a safe exchange location at which
24 parents who exercise time-sharing pursuant to a parenting plan
25 or time-sharing schedule may meet to exchange custody of the
26 minor child.

27 (b) Each sheriff's office or substation parking lot
28 designated as a safe exchange location must install a purple
29 light on the parking lot premises to clearly identify the
30 designated area as a safe exchange location. The safe exchange
31 location must:

32 1. Be accessible 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

33 2. Provide adequate lighting and an external video
34 surveillance system that records continuously, 24 hours a day, 7
35 days a week.

36 3. Provide at least one camera which is fixed on the
37 parking lot, which is able to record the area in the vicinity of
38 the purple light during both day and night, which records images
39 that clearly and accurately display the time and date, and which

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40 retains video surveillance recordings or images for at least 45
41 days.

42 (c) A cause of action shall not lie against the county,
43 the sheriff, a county commissioner, a law enforcement officer,
44 or an employee of the designated safe exchange location based on
45 any incident arising out of a meeting at a safe exchange
46 location pursuant to this subsection.

47 Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2023.
