Remove lines 273-286 and insert:

6 number of hospital admissions and emergency department visits
 7 for the previous calendar year for which payments for medical
 8 assistance and related services on behalf of the patients who
 9 are determined to be eligible subject to the income, assets, and
 10 categorical eligibility tests set forth in federal and state
 11 law. The report must also describe information relating to the
 12 costs of care for Medicaid eligible persons in this state
 13 receiving available financial benefits as a result of the
 14 Legislature's failure to expand Medicaid in this state, costs to
 15 patients, and the impact of uncompensated care on the cost or

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16 ability of hospitals to provide services to the public, hospital
17 funding needs, and other related information.
