 9 Constitution. This subsection is subject to the Open Government
 10 Sunset Review Act in accordance with s. 119.15 and shall stand
 11 repealed on October 2, 2029, unless reviewed and saved from
 12 repeal through reenactment by the Legislature.

13 Section 2. The Legislature finds that it is a public
 14 necessity that the personal identifying information of a person
